READ BEFORE USE

Before using the umbrella, you must do the following:

- Install the chosen accessory base appropriately, according to the instructions
 OR
- 2. Get four (4) 18"-20" patio stones (or similar) weighing at least 35 lbs each. Place one (1) patio stone on each of the four (4) sides of the umbrella's cross base legs. The total weight of all four (4) patio stones should be at least 140 lbs. You can use heavier stones if desired.

Before using the lighting system, you must do the following:


- 1. Insert the INPUT end of the transformer [part #118] into a 120V power supply.
- 2. Insert the OUTPUT end of the transformer [part #118] into a power socket.


B.#033: Vent Top Cap F. #100-101: Cross Base G. #094: Support Base

K. #095: Cover for Rotating Swivel Base


Assembly




- -Install the upper cross base [F-#100] to the lower cross base [F-#101].
- -Mount the rotating swivel base [H-#096] to the top of the cross base [F] with four (4) M8x30 bolts (included).
- -Attach the support base [G-#094] to the rotating swivel base [H] with four (4) M8x20 bolts (included).
- -Install the vent top cap [B-#033].
- -Slide the cover for the rotating swivel base [K-#095] over the support base [G].
- -Insert the upper frame [A] into the support base [G] and tighten the thumbscrew.
- -Screw the light bulb [J2-#112] into the light socket, then screw onto the light globe [J1-#109].

Operating & Use







Canopy

-To open the canopy, turn the crank [fig.3A] clockwise.

-To close the canopy, turn the crank [fig.3A] counter-clockwise.

NOTE: When cranking, if you feel resistance & the umbrella is not opening, spread the umbrella ribs manually using your hands, then continue to crank.

EZ-Tilt Handle

-To change the angle of the umbrella, squeeze the tilt handle [fig.3B] and move it up or down to the preferred angle.

-To store the umbrella, use ties to secure the canopy fabric.

Lighting System

-Push - - when the moonlight is bright.

-Push = = when the moonlight is dim.

-Push **o** to turn the lights off.


Swivel Base

-Step on the base foot pedal [fig.4C]

-Rotate the umbrella by hand to the desired location.

-Release the foot pedal [fig.4C] to lock the umbrella into position.
